## Recycling Preparation

### RINSE

If not rinsed food debris causes odor and bacteria. Contamination may cause materials to be rejected and sent to the landfills.

### FLATTEN

Save yourself and the recycling bins (or centers) space by flattening cans and plastic. Please do not break glass containers.

### REMOVE LIDS

Metal lids can be recycled, but plastic lids can't. Plastic lids can cause an entire batch of material to be rejected.

### SEPARATE

The recycling bins are divided into different sections. Please use the correct section to avoid contamination. Check with your curbside or recycling center operators to find out how they would like items to be separated.

### REUSE

Store and transport recyclables in reusable containers. Recyclers may not accept material in plastic bags. Do not put plastic bags in the drop off bins.

### REDUCE

If you can't recycle a package—look for an alternative product packaged in a recyclable container!

### Car Batteries

## Personal Computer Recycling

Since 2003 DKMM has been recycling old computers and components. Now the collection is in conjunction with the Appliance Roundup in spring and the HHW events in the fall.

## Tires

Tires should be traded in when new ones are purchased. Tires can be taken to your local transfer station or Liberty Tire Service of Grove City. Both facilities charge a disposal fee. The DKMM Solid Waste District accepts tires at its household hazardous waste events in September or October.

## Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Every September or October DKMM offers a HHW collection event. Latex paint will no longer be accepted. Call your local **Recycling & Litter Prevention Office page 3** of this guide for more information.

## Paint

Donate used/useable paint to churches, organizations, youth groups, community theater that might use it for special projects. The “**Habitat for Humanity**” **Re-Store**, 305 Curtis St, Delaware, **740-369-4505** and **Habitat for Humanity**” **Re-Store of Knox County**, 120 S. Norton St, Mt. Vernon, **740-393-1434** are non-profit organizations that will also take used paint and other home improvement items. Call for details and hours of operations.

Drying Latex Paint

You can put latex-based paint in a box or bag and dry it with kitty litter or shredded newspaper. Some home improvements stores sell a paint hardener made by Napier Environmental Technology, Inc. that will also dry latex paint and you will be able to dispose of it in your regular trash. Make sure the empty paint is recycled properly.

## Abitibi Paper Retriever Program

In 2004, Abitibi Consolidated contracted with **Delaware & Knox Counties** for their paper recycling program. Abitibi Recycling provides this program at no cost. Bright green and yellow containers, called paper retrievers, are placed in highly visible, convenient areas where residents and businesses can drop off their paper waste; i.e. newspapers, magazines and junk mail. The Paper Retriever program has been recognized nationally for its successful recovery rate. Abitibi Recycling is committed to providing this program since it is an end-user of the paper we collect. Recovered paper is directed to processing centers where it is sorted into various grades and prepared for shipment. It is then routed to Abitibi's de-inking facilities and mills where it is used to manufacture 100% recycled content newsprint. By diverting this paper from the waste stream, we estimate that over 2.2 million cubic yards of landfill space is saved each year.
